



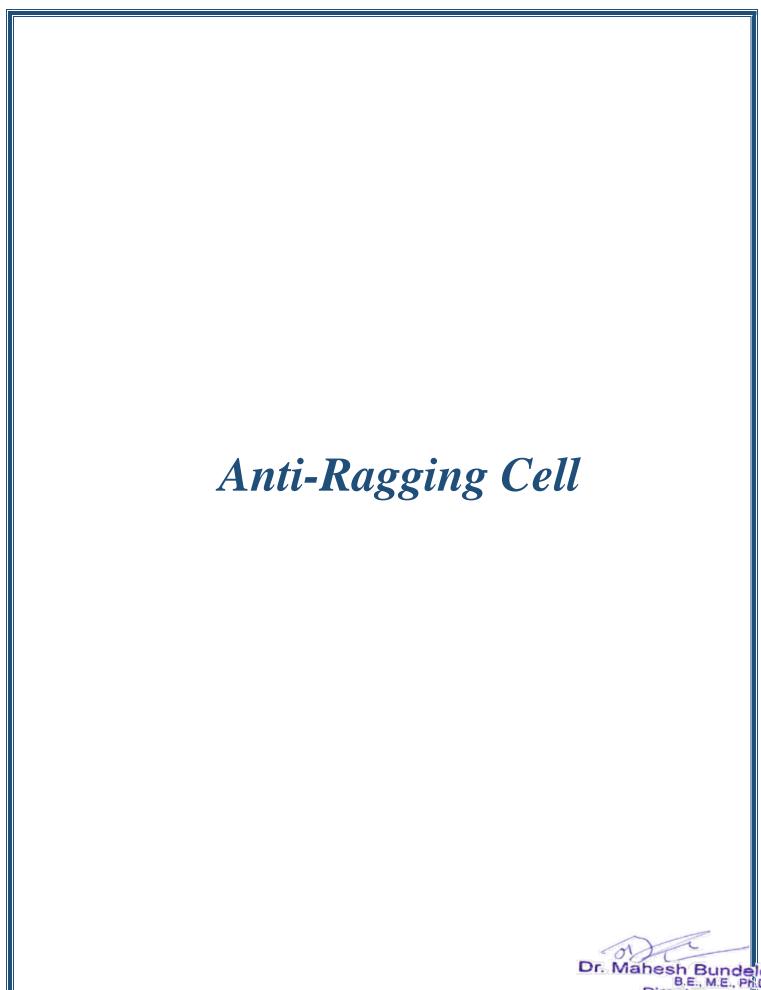

Sub.: Formation of College Level Anti-ragging committee and squads- Reg.

Ref: Directives of the Supreme Court of India, dated May 16, 2007 in SLP No. (s) 24295 of 2006. University of Kerala Vs Council, Principals', Colleges, Kerala & Ors with SLP(C) No. 24296-99/2004 & W.P. (Crl) No. 173/2006 and SLP (C) No. 14356/2005) and Civil Appeal no. 887 of 887 of 2009 dated May 8, 2009.

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India admitted and heard the above referred SLPs in relation to the menace of ragging in Technical Institutions/Universities/Colleges in the Country. In this connection, a committee headed by Dr. R.K. Raghavan, former Director of CBI, for giving specific recommendations on effective prevention of ragging in educational institutions was constituted by the apex court. Accordingly, the Committee had carried out a very detailed study on the various factors contributing for ragging and collected the public opinion. Further, the Committee had submitted a detailed report with suitable recommendations and measures required to effectively curb the menace. The recommendations of the Committee were duly accepted. The following directives have been issued to all the educational institutes for necessary implementation by the Hon'ble Court and this institute proposes to follow them.

- I. Factors enlisted by committee:
- 1. Primary responsibility for curbing ragging rests with academic institutions themselves.
- 2. Ragging adversely impacts the standards of higher education.
- 3. Incentives should be available to institution for curbing the menace and there should be disincentives for failure to do so.
- 4. Enrolment in academic pursuits or a campus life should not immunize any adult citizen from penal provisions of the laws of the land.
- 5. Ragging needs to be perceived as failure to inculcate human values from the schooling stage.
- 6. Behavioral patterns among students, particularly potential 'raggers', need to be identified.
- 7. Measures against ragging must deter its recurrence.
- 8. Concerted action is required at the level of the school, higher educational institution, district administration, university, State and Central Governments to make any curb effective.
- 9. Media and the Civil Society should be involved in this exercise.

II. Recommendations approved by the Supreme Court:

- 1. The punishment to be meted out has to be exemplary and justifiable harsh to act as a deterrent against recurrence of such incidents.
- 2. Every single incident of ragging where the victim or his parent/guardian or the Head of Institution is not satisfied with the institutional arrangement for action, a First Information Report must be filled without exception by the institutional authorities with the local police authorities. Any failure on the part of the institutional authority or negligence or deliberate delay in lodging the FIR with the local police shall be construed to be an act of culpable negligence on the part of the institutional authority. If any victim or his parent/guardian of ragging intends to file FIR directly with the

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- police, that will not absolve the institutional authority from the requirement of filing the FIR.
- 3. In the prospectus to be issued for admission by educational institutions, it shall be clearly stipulated that in case the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later that he has indulged in ragging, admission may be refused or he shall be expelled from the educational institution.
- 4. It shall be the collective responsibility of the authorities and functionaries of the concerned institution and their role shall also be open to scrutiny for the purpose of finding out whether they have taken effective steps for preventing ragging and in case of their failure, action can be taken, for example, denial of any grant-in-aid or assistance from the State Governments.
- 5. Anti-ragging committees and Squads shall be forthwith formed by the institutions and it shall be the job of the committee or the squad, as the case may be, to see that the Committee's recommendations, more particularly those noted above, are observed without exception and if it is noticed that there is any deviation, the same shall be forthwith brought to the notice of this Court.
- 6. The Committee constituted pursuant to the order of this Court shall continue to monitor the functioning of the anti-ragging committees and the squads to be formed. They shall also monitor the implementation of the recommendations to which reference has been made above.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR) CELL

1. INTRODUCTION OF IPR CELL

The Poornima College of Engineering's IPR Cell is established to motivate, encourage, and recognize the contributions of students and faculty members towards intellectual property rights (IPR). This cell is dedicated to providing support on prior-art searches, providing opinions on the patentability of research work, drafting patent specifications as per the requirement of the IP agency, assembling filing materials, submitting applications, and following up, on pursuing filed applications. In addition to responding to FERs and other office actions, prosecuting filed applications, providing advisory services on various IPRs, managing IP, reviewing the College's IP policy, and organizing workshops, conferences, and expert talks on IPR is also managed by this cell. As the cell accumulates expertise, it will also serve as a think tank on IPR policy concerns in India, focusing particularly on local challenges.

The main goal of an IPR Cell is to integrate IPR with the educational process to nurture critical thinking, propagate a culture of preserving rights, ensure prompt and accurate identification and protection of innovations resulting from research work conducted in the college, facilitate knowledge transfer from the College to industry, and broaden the scope of their commercialization. The Cell also intends to help regional innovators at the grassroots level realize the economic advantages of their discoveries.

2. AIMS & OBJECTIVES

The IPR policies of PCE are formulated to establish an environment that encourages faculty, students, supervisors, and researchers in the college to recognize and value their research, creativity, and innovation while also assisting in the orderly translation of such inventions, and technologies for the use of industry and societal benefit, which in turn transforms into services for the largest possible audience.

It will cover the IP properties technological concepts and products produced by the individual student, team of students and faculty members, etc. Any such IP from the labor of the innovators will be successfully handled throughout its life cycle period. The IPR policies are meant to act as a set of rules for the students, faculties, and staff members and the following are the key features of the IPR Cell of the institute.



- To improve the culture of innovation and research as the center for academic research.
- To promote the sharing of ideas by honoring and celebrating among academics, staff, inventors, and researchers.
- To create an atmosphere in the institution, that encourages innovation by making the necessary resources accessible to increase innovative capacity.
- To defend and protect the rights of innovators, such as students, researchers, teachers, and ultimately the college, by submitting in proper format to the relevant IP authorities.
- To ensure commercialization of granted IP to raise funds for additional research and to distribute the profits from the exchange of IP to all the innovators.
- To establish a system of IP ownership, its management, and proper distribution so that it is transparent and increases compliance with the existing IP laws and regulations.

3. OWNERSHIP

IP ownership is determined by several factors and by each specific situation. It all relies on how the innovators have conducted their research. There may be a single invention or IP to which numerous individuals made varying contributions, or they may be supported by outside organizations. Therefore, it is crucial to establish ownership and assignment rights for any creative works produced as a result of sponsored and/or collaborative activity or based on special requirements relating to Intellectual Property assets emerging from contracts controlling such activity. If the conditions of such ownership and assignment rights are not made clear before the creation of any creation or innovation at the college, whether it was done alone or with others, with or without a significant contribution from the college, the college will hold the intellectual property rights. However, the ownership of IP shall be determined as under:

- Any IP must belong to the PCE where its resources are primarily utilized for the conduction of research activities
- If a faculty member, staff, student individual, or team creates any IP during their course duration (for students) or normal working hours, such rights will be reserved by PCE only.
- If an IP is proposed and processed through some sponsored research, then can be such IP will be determined according to the terms & conditions of the sponsored Bund



- However, inventors must bring this matter to the IPR cell.
- The committee must be consulted in any controversy involving IP ownership. The committee's decision on this matter shall be final and binding upon all parties.

3. ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

3.1 Institute Responsibilities

- To educate the faculty and students about IP through the IPR cell by Organising different events around the year.
- To offer financial and essential legal assistance for submitting an IP application or existing IP commercialization.
- The promotion and commercialization of college-owned IP, as well as legal assistance for inventors to prevent improper use of college IP.
- To equally distribute the profits from the commercialization of existing IP to innovators.
- Keeping IP records up to date for their life cycle and making sure that any conflicts between sponsors, institutes, and inventors are resolved.

3.2 Inventor Responsibilities

- The IP owner must disclose all inventions and associated documentation that belong to the college by the policy.
- Invention documents, including notebooks and digital recordings related to research
 efforts, must be kept by the inventor and made available to the institute and should made
 available as and when required.
- By the policy, the inventor must also transfer IP rights to the college and assist with technology transfer initiatives and related legal proceedings.
- All potential conflicts of interest must be immediately disclosed by the inventor to the IPR cell.

4. IPR COMMITTEE

The Policy shall be administered by an IPR Cell consisting of the following members appointed on the recommendation of CG members. The composition of the IPR Coll State as follows:



- The Director (Chairman)
- The Vice Principal (Vice Chairman)
- Head, IPR Cell
- 2 to 3 Faculty Members

The committee will primarily look after and recommend

- The conduction of awareness and training activities regarding the creation of IPR and its importance throughout the year.
- review the existing IP Policies and submit an annual report to the Registrar'soffice.
- Review on evaluate procedures of IP proposal applications to encourage the innovators.
- Resolve the disputes between the innovators and institutes.
- The appointment of The Head, IPR Cell, or committee members who will look after the management and working of IPR cell activities.

Inventors who believe they have generated an IP using college resources should approach the IPR Cell with all the information, manuscripts, sketches, drawings, data, results, and prototype products. The documentation on the technology product that has been developed must include a thorough specification, information on the IP, a list of all inventors, and other necessary information. Additionally, the creators should attest to the work's uniqueness and ensure no other researcher has ever published it.

She explained how IPR safeguards designs, trademarks, songs, literature, symbols, and names, allowing inventors to retain ownership rights and gain monetary advantages for varying periods. Dr. Bansal captivated the audience with engaging videos, graphics, and illustrations related to patent application drafting.

She stressed the significance of patents in enhancing the institution's NAAC and NIRF rankings. Dr. Bansal further clarified the National Intellectual Property Rights Policy 2016, its objectives, and different forms of IPR with relevant examples. An interactive session followed, where the audience enthusiastically participated in identifying IP protection for provided images.

The session covered patents, non-patentable subject matter, patentability criteria, patent procedures including steps and fees, and the role of the Patent Office. Copyrights and the procedure for obtaining them, particularly in cases of plagiarism, were also discussed. *BRIEF DETAILS ABOUT CHIEF SPEAKER:

Dr. Raj is an Associate Professor in the Department of Mechanical Engineering, at Poornima College of Engineering, Jaipur, Rajasthan. He is Head of IPR cell at Poornima College of Engineering, and mentoring faculty members and students on patent filing.

*ABSTRACT/BRIEF DETAIL OF THE ACTIVITY:

At the beginning of the session, Dr. Raj demonstrated the process of reviewing the existing patents to ensure they are relevant to the proposed invention. He explained using the official websites of the United States Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO), European Patent Office (EPO), IP India, and Google Patents using an online patent database. He informed the participants about the keywords and classification codes to narrow their search, and how one can cite the relevant patents in a new patent document, acknowledging prior art and demonstrating the novelty of any invention.

Later He explained that several forms need to be prepared before filing a patent application. These forms may vary depending on the jurisdiction, but common forms he listed includes

- **Application form:** Provides basic information about the applicant, inventor, and invention.
- **Declaration or oath:** Affirms the inventorship and ownership of the invention.
- **Specification:** Describes the invention in detail, including its features, advantages, and embodiments.
- **Drawings:** Visual representations of the invention to aid in understanding.

He mentioned that an applicant should ensure to fill out these forms accurately and completely to avoid delays or rejections in the patenting process. Monitoring the status of filed or existing patents is essential to stay informed about their progress. The inventor may follow the following steps to check the patent status using the application number:

- Visit the official patent office website, such as the IP India office, in case the patent is filed in India.
- Navigate to the patent search or application status section.
- Enter the application number or patent number.
- Review the status updates, including examination progress, publication, and grant.

Regularly monitoring the patent status helps track the progress of your patents and stay informed about competitors' patents. To file patents electronically, creating an account on the respective patent filing portal is necessary. Here's a guide to creating and activating your account:

- Visit the official website of the patent office, such as the USPTO or EPO.
- Locate the "Sign Up" or "Create Account" option.
- Provide the required personal and contact information.
- Verify your email address or phone number through the verification link or code sent.
- Follow the prompts to set up your account password and security questions.
- Log in to your account using the created credentials.

Activating your account enables you to access various patent services, including filing new applications, checking status, and managing existing patents. In the end, he demonstrated the published patents, of existing students and staff of the institute
