But due to unhealthy food and sedentary life style we damage our liver and bear consequences. Further he provided some tips to keep our Liver healthy. He highlighted on to-

- Consume a healthy, balanced diet
- Limit sugar and salt intake
- Include more green veggies and fresh fruits in your diet
- Maintain a healthy weight in accordance with BMI
- Regular exercise is the key to a healthy lifestyle
- Eat sprouted pulses like mung, matki, black channa, green channa and sprouted wheat, as it greatly increases the liver's cleansing properties.

The session was quite knowledgeable and students asked many questions to the doctor. The session ended with presenting a memento to the guest by Dr. Kuldip Sharma and Dr. Sarveen Kaur Sachdeva as a token of gratitude.

Short films focusing on environmental conservation and sustainable living were screened, inspiring the audience to take action for a greener future.

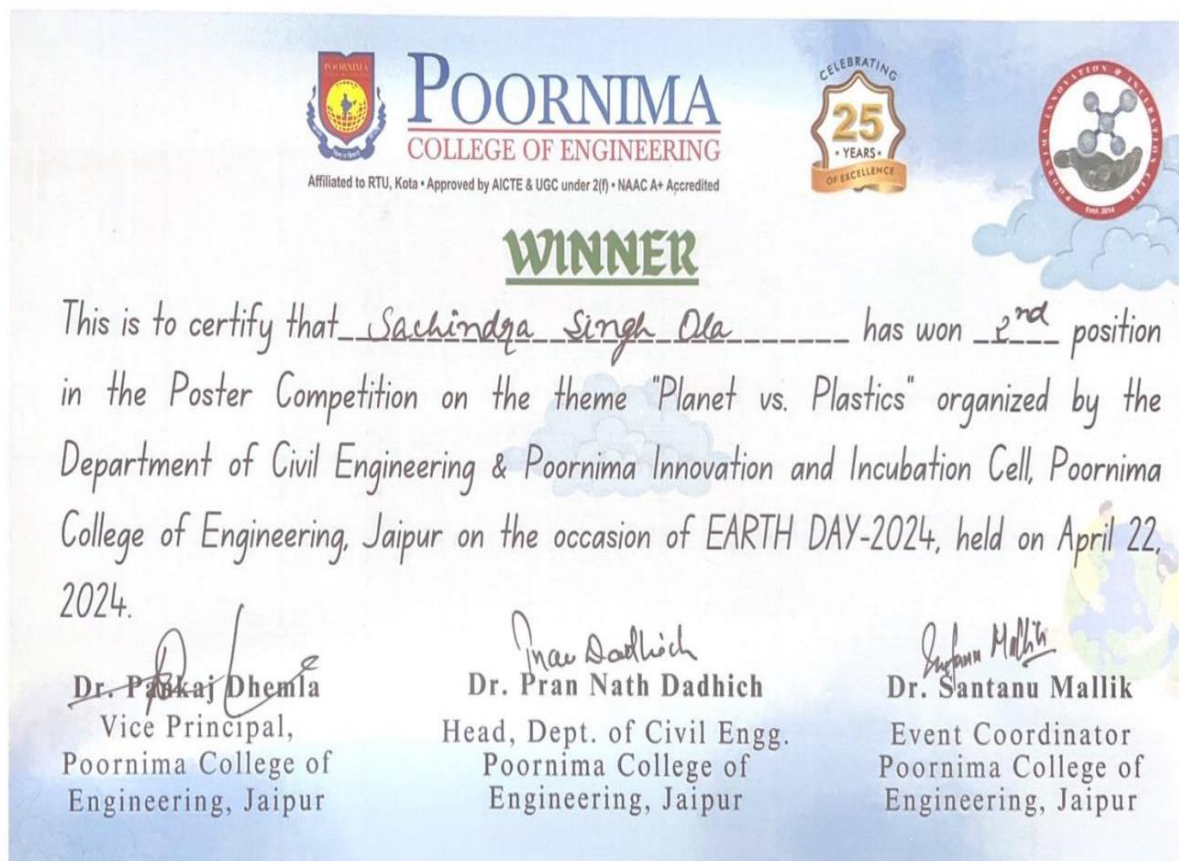
13. Vote of Thanks by Dr. Santanu Malik:
