So, women at PCE have clasped and formed a club called Women in Science and Engineering (WISE) to propagate the importance and relevance of women education in science and engineering. Every year activities of WISE have been organized with the coordination of the concerned department to encourage the maximum participation of girls in various activities and to promote their overall development. For the motivation a poster competition on the topic, "Girls are the Spirit of our Nation" has been organized by the entity to promote the girl students and female members and an exhibition is promoted on this virtual platform. It stands for **Women in Science and Engineering** that formally aims to strengthen the technological scenario in which women are going to play a key role. 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they need strength & a strong identity to build a strong society for which WISE was established. Various social programs like visits to hospitals, slum houses, and orphanage, etc. are organized at regular intervals under WISE. A woman cannot only change anything but also can change everything. “Women are the real Architect of Society”. So, women at PCE have clasped and formed a club Women in Science and Engineering WISE to propagate importance and relevance of women education in science and engineering.

To provide a safe teaching and working experience in campus of PCE, rules for prevention and redressed of ragging/harassment are as follows-

- The aggrieved women/girl shall present a written complaint to PWWA committee.
- If aggrieved women are unable to make complaint on physical in capacity and mental capacity the complaint shall be filed by her legal heirs.
- The complaints shall submit the supporting documents, name and address of witness.
- The PWWA committee shall further enquire if complaint is found to be true
- The PWWA committee shall enquire in accordance with the principle of natural justice keeping all the rights with it to terminate the enquiry proceedings.
- The cross examination of witness shall be followed in the decorum and dignity.
- Any suitable penalty may be imposing alleged by the PWWA committee, if all allegations are proved.
- Appropriate actions shall be taken against the complainant if all the allegations are malicious or false.
- There cord shall be maintained in the complaint register.
- The withdrawal of complaint shall be allowed on the basis of written application presented by accused to PWWA committee.
- All rights shall remain reserved with PWWA committee in the concern of complaint/redressal/withdrawal/penalty.

Every year activities of WISE have been organized with the coordination of the concerned department to encourage the maximum participation of girls in various activities and to promote their overall development. For the selection of Student coordinators, a Google form will be circulated, which shall be filled by the students interested. An interview will be conducted for the students, who have filled the form and student coordinators will be selected as per the interview.

**Selection criteria:**

- Enthusiasm and determination to uplift status of women in technical field.
- Creative and innovative ideas regarding club activities.
- Leadership quality to lead club activities
- Ability to coordinate club activities.
- Potential to manage details and follow through among the members are held every month to work on the empowerment of the female students of our college and planning are always made and the work of execution has been given to each and every member of the group.

## SESSIONS CONDUCTED

### FIRST YEAR GIRL'S VISITED TO INDIA'S LARGEST BUSINESS INCUBATOR CENTER "BHAMASHAH TECHNO HUB" JAIPUR (27<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 2019)

First year girls of Gayatri girls Hostel PCE & day scholar of Poornima College of Engineering visited India's largest Business Incubator center **Bhamashah Techno Hub (BTH), Jaipur** on 27<sup>th</sup> March, 2019 under the guidance of Mrs. Sudha Jain Chief warden Gayatri girls Hostel and Mrs Meena tekriwal & Ms. Riddhi Shrivastava, Assistant Professor, Chemistry, First year. BTH is a project by the Government of Rajasthan to accelerate the pace of creating a compelling startup ecosystem in Rajasthan. The idea is to provide an entire support system to the rising entrepreneurs by helping them to pitch their ideas and get connected with the potential investors. The incubation centre offers free space, connectivity, easier funding, mentorship and exposure to the startups. Total 100 girls from first year visited the hub. Students reached incubation hub at 10 am.

Ms. Kiran, Administrative officer at BTH and an investor conducted an informative session about

  
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Bhamashah Incubation hub and about its working and how they help in encouraging the vibrant startups.

A number of questions were discussed by girls in the session which include how a startup gains funds



at different stages? What is a perspective of an investor? Students learnt about what is startup? Why

to start? What is right mindset? How things are connected? What is innovation? Too many more such type of questions was discussed in the session. After this session, Students visited Tinkering labs, there they saw a number of high-tech stuff like **VR, 3D printer, voice controlled car, and Bluetooth controller's** etc. Hub has different floors for different type of presentations. Ground floor of BTH building had a **reception** area. First floor has **cafeteria**. From 2nd to 4th there are offices for a **large number of startups** along with **auditorium** on 2nd floor and **Tinkering Lab** with **mentor boxes** on 4th floor, this floor is heart of BTH. 5th floor has **Gym** and **Sleeping pods**. These are used by hard working entrepreneurs to regain their energy. 7th and 8th floor is **digital museum**. It is full of modern technologies like mind **wave readers, 7D theatres, and a wide range of virtual reality games, rob soccer**. 7th and 8th floor represent the coming future of technology. ### **WOMEN HEALTH AWARENES PROGRAM (12<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY 2019)**
