

Gender Equality and Woman Rights in India

Poornima College of Engineering, Jaipur



Recent data released by the National Legal Services Authority (NALSA) suggest that the nationwide lockdown has led to a rapid increase in cases of domestic violence. The data, which is categorized according to cases in different states, suggest that Uttarakhand recorded the highest number of domestic violence cases in the last two months of lockdown. Haryana ranks on number two and the national capitalDelhi on number three.

The Novel Corona disease not only had medical practitioners, scientists and other frontline workers overworked, even social scientists, lawyers, social scientists had their hands full and occupied. The Novel virus resulted in one of the largest migration in history of world with migrants moving across the highways on foot, in scorching heat, in trains and buses .However what remains the same despite a span of almost 7 decades is that women and children remain as vulnerable as ever.

People were directed to stay indoors and political and bureaucratic machinery went full throttle to implement the lockdown with police personnel deployed out on streets to prevent any movement unless in case of emergency.

While deserted streets may have brought a ray of hope for government which bought some time to develop and implement some strategies for containment of virus, it crushed the tiniest semblance of hope for a large number of vulnerable section of society; women and children, and exposed them to the danger of domestic violence and made situations worse for the ones who were already facing it .Trapped inside their houses they had no escape from the perpetuators

How lockdown has been breeding ground of fresh cases of domestic violence and worsened the existing ones was evident from surge of phone calls to the helpline numbers of various government and non—government organizations. The lockdown has impacted the economic and social aspect of country and almost all strata of society has borne the brunt in some ways or other. Number of researches show that insecurity has high co-relation with negative emotions like stress, anxiety, restlessness, irritability and anger issues. The permission to open liquor outlets with lockdown still in progress saw the plight of women increase manifold and were subjected to domestic violence in its worst form ever.

The numerous calls to helpline numbers are just the tip of the iceberg. Many cases of physical, mental,



Psychological, emotional and sexual abuse went unnoticed and not reported. There must thousands and lakh of women who were beaten mercilessly, abused emotionally and must have faced marital rape resulting in unwanted pregnancies with no discretion on their part to decide whether to continue or discard the pregnancy, left with little or absolutely no reproductive rights to exercise.

From opening liquor outlets, to flooding social media with distasteful sexist jokes, the lockdown had been absolutely blind to woes of women who worked from home with additional burden of daily chores which was reduced because of house helps who couldn't move due to lockdown, to physical, mental, psychological, emotional and sexual abuse at hands of intimate partners and family members. Why the lockdown was imposed in such a haste with no prior planning and consideration of women facing domestic violence is largely due to patriarchal mind set of society that overlook insignificant matters likedomestic violence in times of a pandemic where only medical and economic concerns deserve attention.

Domestic violence results in adverse effects on physical, mental, psychological, emotional, sexual and reproductive health of the survivor and as largest democracy in world we must take care of safety and well-being of half of our population. The pandemic should not give birth to another pandemic, that of domestic violence and while we are hopeful that soon a solution in terms of vaccine may be available for corona virus, it will take an exceptionally long to find a solution to the of domestic violencekeeping into account our social, legal and psychological limitations

Every person deserves to reach her or his full potential, but gender inequalities in theirlives and in the lives of those who care for them hinder this reality.

Across India gender inequality results in unequal opportunities, and while it impacts on the lives of both genders, statistically it is women that are the most disadvantaged.

The principle of gender equality is enshrined in the Indian Constitution in its Preamble, Fundamental Rights, Fundamental Duties and Directive Principles. The Constitution notonly grants equality to women, but also empowers the State to adopt measures of positive discrimination in favour of women. 


















PROTECTION OF WOMEN FROM DOMESTIC VIOLENCE ACT (2005)

• DETAILS OF ACTIVITY:





DETAILS OF TECHNOLOGICAL / PRACTICAL LEARNINGS:

- Women are the core of the existence of any and every part of the universe. It is indispensable to overlook their valuable contribution. Keeping in pace with the present requisites, IETE propose-week a training program on "Internet Uses" under the banner of 'Digital India'. "A great endeavor requires expert guidance." A one-day workshop activity was organized by the department of Electronics and Communication Engineering, Poornima College of Engineering on 24th July 2017. This was a noble effort supported by Dr. Om Prakash Sharma, Director, Poornima College of Engineering, and Dr. Garima Mathur, Head Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering in which 7 students of 3rd year, Khushboo Chhabra, Jyoti Singh, Laksh, Prashant, Arya Rawat, Ayushi Parashar, Divya along with 3 faculty members, Gaurav Saxena, Manish Kumar Sharma, Anila Dhingra visited Chaksu village. In Chaksu, they went to the school Unique Shine Children Academy. Our efforts for creating were mutually supported by Mr. Trilok Kumar Sharma, Principal of Unique Shine Children Academy.
- This was a women-centric activity that aimed to enlighten urban/rural housewives about the wonders that internet technology offers in easing day-to-day life. The students gave PowerPoint presentations about the use of various policies of government such as Net Banking, Aadhar card, and Bhamashah card i.e., how they can be useful to smoothen daily life. Students also created awareness among the women about the uses and the bits of internet banking in rural areas. Students told them about:
- Net Banking: Net banking also known as internet banking, e-banking or virtual banking, is an electronic payment system that enables customers of a bank or other financial institution to Conduct a range of financial transactions through the financial institution's website. The online banking system typically connects to be part of the core banking system operated by a bank and is in contrast to branch banking which was the traditional way customers accessed banking services. Women in rural areas were not aware of thinking and how to transfer their money from one account to another account.
- Aadhar card: Students told them what aadhar card is; The Aadhaar UID Card is produced and distributed by the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI). It is the largest personal identification program the world has ever witnessed. Over 1.2 billion people are eligible to receive the Aadhaar card. The only requirement to be eligible for an Aadhaar card is that every person must be a permanent resident of India. They told them what the importance of Aadhar card is and why it is needed for everyone.



- Bhamashah Card: Bhamashah Yojana is a scheme introduced by the Government of Rajasthan to transfer financial and non-financial benefits of governmental schemes directly to recipients in a transparent way. Education is not only an instrument of enhancing efficiency but also an effective tool of augmenting and widening democratic participation and upgrading the overall quality of individuals and Society. India has a vast population and to capture the potential demographic dividend, and remove acute regional, social, and gender imbalances, the Government and various private organizations are committed making concerted efforts for improving the quality of education in rural areas for women.
- Women's education in ancient India was quite good but in the middle age has deteriorated because of
 restrictions against women. However, again it is getting better and better day by day as modern people in
 India understand that without the growth and development of women, the development of the country is
 not possible. It then is very true that equal growth of both males and females will increase development
 in every area of the country.
