



#### **ROBO RACE:**

Autonomous or wired racing robots are the focus of the competition. The goal of the competition is to increase robot driving skills by creating more realistic race circumstances. There won't be any stop signs or traffic lights, and all vehicles must come to a safe stop after each race.

#### **ROBO SOCCER:**

The basic purpose of this game is to direct your robots to score as many goals as you can. A specialized autonomous robot is a soccer robot. On the other hand, bots are capable of intense competition with wired and wireless bots. Each team must score and defend the goal on the other team's side. Each team could have a maximum of four participants.

#### **ROBO WAR:**

The primary tactic used by either side, whether it be defending or attacking, is considered while creating the bots. There is a 5-person maximum per squad. Five minutes will be allotted for each match. Only timeouts lasting 30 seconds and a maximum of twice a game allow teams to shift their bots. It is not permitted to strike engines or cables, just certain body parts.

#### **EXHIBITION:**

Exhibitions consist of all the robots and bots which students made from scratch under the name of AADHAR events. All the machines made during and for AADHAR is presented in this exhibition for the general, guest, and other participating public. Schools and colleges can also come and exhibit their project as well.

#### • CIRCUITRY: -

The circuitry is the science of designing electronic or electric circuits, or it is the detailed layout of an electric circuit. The most crucial component of electronics is circuitry. Circuitry enables us to create and test the existing circuits and examinent with various configurations to obtain a unique outcome each time.

• MACHINE-O-MANIA: -

A hand on the opportunity to explore and expand your imagination. design the machine you desire. Your creativity, originality, and innovation, as well as the persistence of your model's efficiency, are all put to the test in this competition. Bring your ideas and thoughts to this robot to make something you can only imagine real.

#### **COSMO CLENCH:**

The participating teams must build a manually controlled gripper bot (wired or wireless) that can grip objects and put them in target zones while overcoming the hurdles in the path with minimum time.

#### **SPUD GUN:**

A toy gun shoots a potato plug by forcing the air in the barrel to condense, sending the potato projectile flying out quickly. A little toy gun called a "spud gun" is used to shoot a potato. To fire, one uses the hollow point of the gun to pierce a potato's surface and pry out a tiny pellet that fits in the muzzle. When the grip is squeezed, a tiny amount of internal air pressure builds up and the toy launches the missile. The devices are often low-powered and short-range.

#### **CODING COMPETITION:**

Coding competition enables you to locate the best solution as quickly as feasible. It assists in making these trade-offs, and in this situation, where you must decrease the time and complexity of your code and discover the best solution, this skill is quite important.

#### **BOAT RUSH:**

In this event, you are required to prepare a boat that is supposed to overcome all the hurdles in the water and reach a particular spot in each time. The maximum number of participants should not be more than 2 per team.
