Objectives of activities


- To sustain and deepen the fabric of traditionally existing emotional links amongst the people of our country by celebrating our nation's unity in diversity.



DAY-2, Tuesday March 9, 2022




DAY-3, Wednesday March 9, 2022


DAY-4, Thursday, March 10, 2022
