Founded in 1998, it sells its licenses to universities and high schools that then use the service

website to check submitted documents against its database and the content of other websites with

the aim of identifying plagiarism. Results can identify similarities with existing sources and can

also be used in formative assessment to help students learn to avoid plagiarism and improve their

writing.

proprietary algorithm. It scans its own databases and also has licensing agreements with large

academic proprietary databases.


