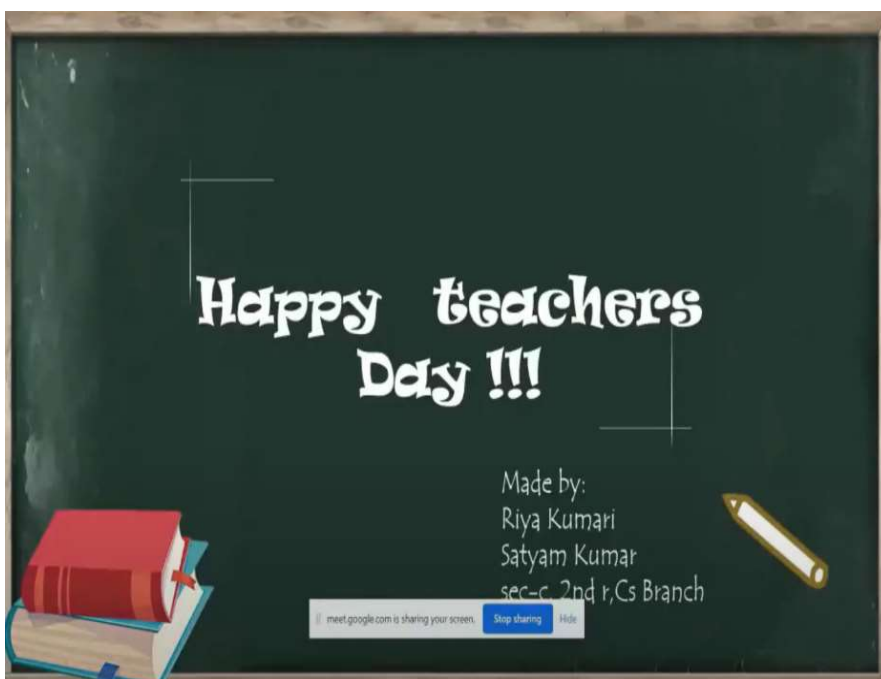
GLIMPSES:
