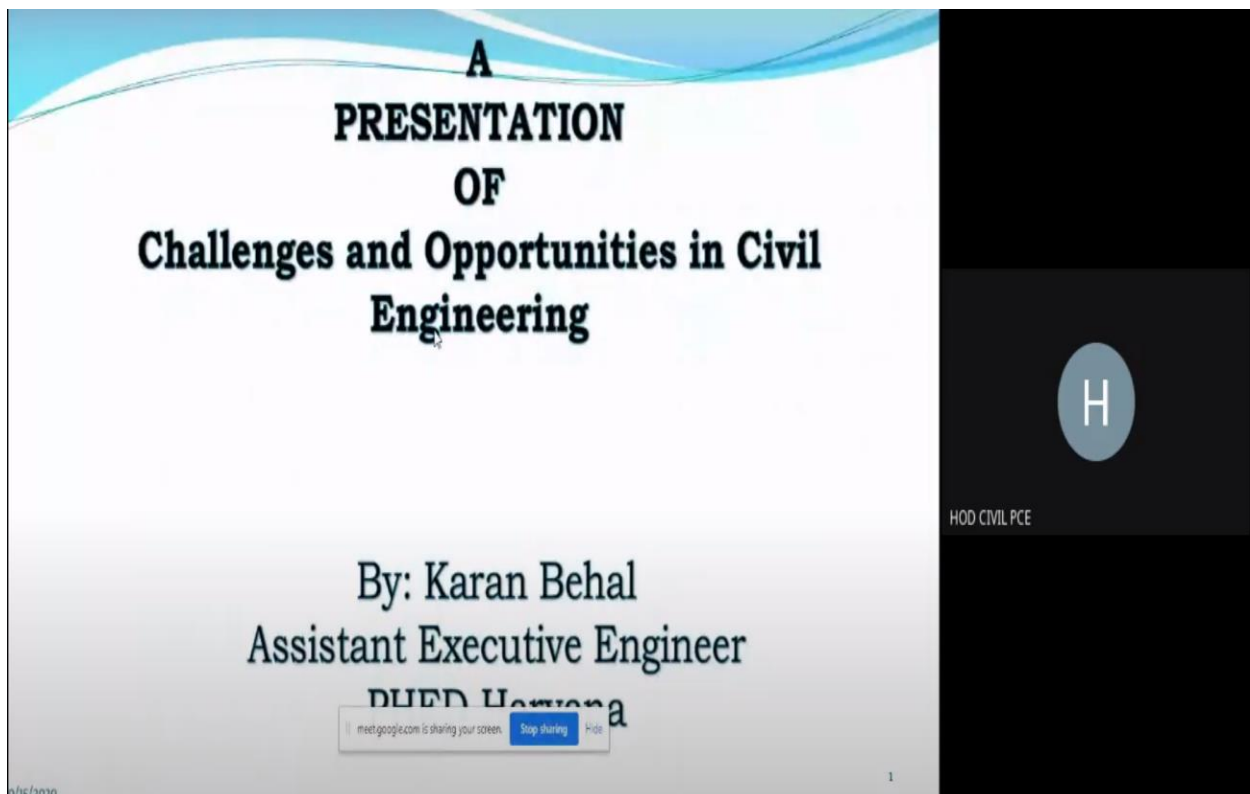
Mr. Balwan Sheshma, Head of Department, Civil Engineering, and Poornima College of Engineering introduce about topic and speaker.
