Students' Council PCE

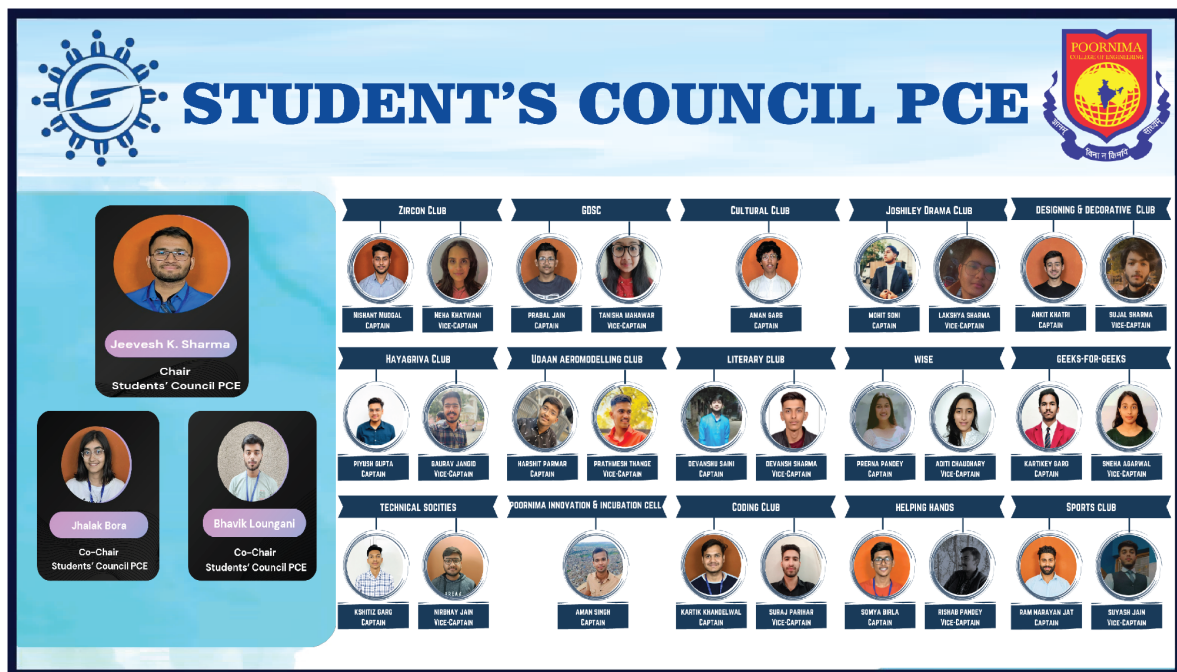
